3. Update from Susan Smieja: United Way giving tree.
  - a. Sometimes our older adults get forgotten with these gift drives. We've gotten more than 50 gifts!! Plus there were some children's gifts that were bought for St. Josephs on the south side.
4. Alderwoman Coggs - representative of the 6th district. In a really sweet moment, Alderwoman Coggs took the stage to personally say farewell to Molly after 8 years of dedicated service as the President of our board.
5. General Business
  - a. Crime and Safety - Officer Colwell gave some statistics and advice. It is listed below:
    - i. Overall reported crime is down 43% (way less motor vehicle thefts)
    - ii. Burglaries are up - mostly unoccupied homes OR garages
    - iii. There has also been a 50% decrease in aggravated assaults.
    - iv. Colwell suggests that interested neighbors should consider going to the crime and safety meetings from D5 - you get 1:1 interaction with the captain of D5 (you actually could potentially make a difference - get an extra patrol, etc.)

  - c. New Bylaws were introduced (regarding our charitable outreach)
