 - i. 232 E Brown St: Proposal for 4-unit development (vacant lot at NWC Brown & Hubbard)

The consensus seemed to be a preference for 3 bedroom townhomes, greenspace, and a setback from sidewalk. Regina, the owner, agreed that she would not be making spaces for short term rentals. Since there were no strong opinions, oppositions or additional feedback,we would like to move forward without objection to the plans. We will reach out to Mike and Regina and communicate that we as an organization don't have any objections, but we will note that we would like it included in the deed restrictions that this property will not allow short term rentals.
